

## 2015 Fornacina Brunello di Montalcino

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Simone Biliorsi's Fornacina 2015 Brunello di Montalcino is earthy and ripe on first nose with dark fruit, plum and dried blackberry. The wine offers traditional or old-school appeal, thanks to its classic lines and its robust fruit profile. A deeply savory quality is promoted here, and you'll want to pair this hearty Tuscan red with a wintery meat dish such as lamb stew. Dark spice, licorice, tar and cedar smoke fill in the rear, adding elegance and complexity. Approximately 12,500 bottles were released.
