Fornacina 2011 Brunello di Montalcino Tasted blind. Youthful, deep ruby. Lots of power, depth and richness on the nose, with notes of tobacco and a touch of oak. Concentrated and still a little austere. Muscular tannins and plenty of freshness for further development. (WS) Drink 2016-2026

Fornacina, Riserva 2010 Brunello di Montalcino Tasted blind. Lustrous ruby. Deep nose with hints of spice and lots of red sweet fruit and just the beginning of tobacco and mulch. Amazing structure of crunchy, coating tannins combined with succulent fruit. Tannins determine the fruit-driven finish for the moment. Great length and power, without being heavy.
