The 2007 Brunello di Montalcino Riserva offers up sweet scents of truffle, autumn leaves, anise, spices

and dried cherries. A soft, layered wine, this deceptively mid-weight Brunello nevertheless possesses plenty of underlying structure. I especially

like the way the flavors open up in the glass. Hints of
