2010 [Fornacina Brunello di Montalcino](#) The 2010 Brunello di Montalcino is striking. Beams of supporting tannin provide a firm backbone of structure as this deeply expressive Brunello shows off its personality. Savory herbs, dark red cherry, lavender, smoke and licorice open up in the glass, adding considerable layers of complexity. The tannins could use another few years to soften, but there is a lot to like here.

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2013 [Fornacina](#) La Fornacina's 2013 Rosso di Montalcino is quite beautiful. Freshly cut flowers, mint, sweet red cherries and tobacco are given an extra kick of brightness from the high acidity of the year. Drink this super-expressive, mid-weight Rosso over the next handful of years.
